

# MO-Call Java Quick Start Guide

## What do I need to start MO-Calling?

Before you can make a call you will need the following:

- A registered MO-Call account.
- MO-Call credit on your account.
- The MO-Call software on your phone.

Registering an account and buying MO-Call credit online at [www.mo-call.com](http://www.mo-call.com) is quick, easy and secure.

MO-Call customers from Home countries receive free credit in their local currency when they register a new MO-Call account. MO-Call World customers receive free credit after their first top-up.

## Switching MO-Call on

First, let's find MO-Call on your mobile.

- I. From the Main Menu of your phone open the folder that holds your Applications.

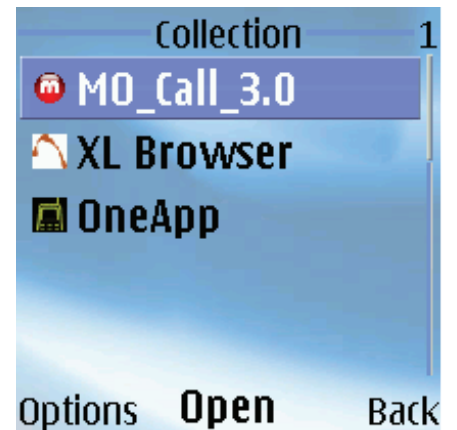
Typically these folders are:

- Nokia: Apps > Collection or Apps > Games
- Sony Ericsson: File Manager > Applications
- Motorola: Games & Apps
- Samsung: Applications > Java World
- LG: My Stuff > Games & Apps > Download

2. Find MO-Call in the list. Open the application to switch MO-Call on.

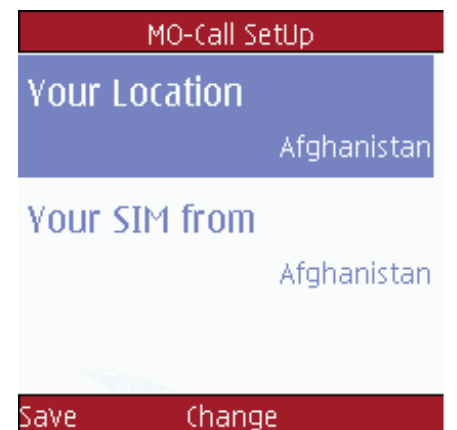


## Setting up MO-Call

The first time you open up MO-Call, you tell the application which country your SIM card is from and which country you're currently located. You can also change these settings at any time in "Menu > Settings"

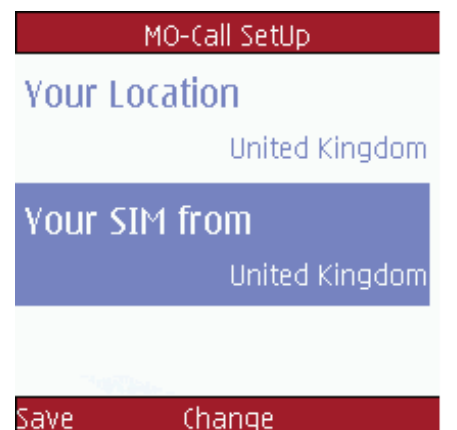
### 1. "Your Location"

Change this to the country that you're in right now. If your country isn't in the list, select "Other"



### 2. "Your SIM from"

Change this to the country that your SIM card is from.




MO-Call will now figure out whether to use calling mode Home or calling mode World. If you ever want to change the calling mode manually yourself, go to “Menu > Settings > MO-Call Service”.

You're now ready to make your first MO-Call.

## Making a call

### Making a call in “Home” mode

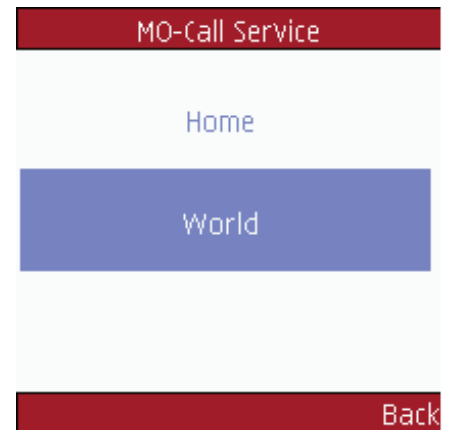
MO-Call Home works by calling the local Morodo network number and then connecting your call, so you actually only make a local call instead of an international call.

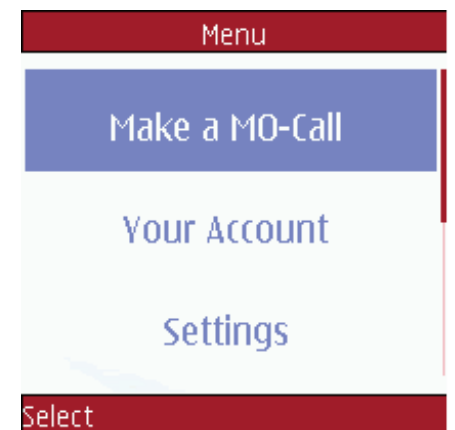
## Making a call in “World” mode

MO-Call World is an SMS triggered callback service. When you dial a number, MO-Call sends an SMS to set up your callback. With MO-Call World, you can specify any fixed or mobile phone to receive the call back. You can select World mode in “Settings >MO-Call Service”.



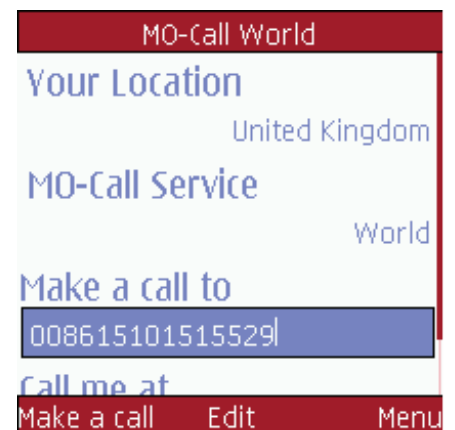
### 1. Open MO-Call

Select “Make a MO-Call”



### 2. Highlight the “Make a call to” field

Select “Edit” and type the number you want to make a call to or select a contact from your phone book then select “OK”.

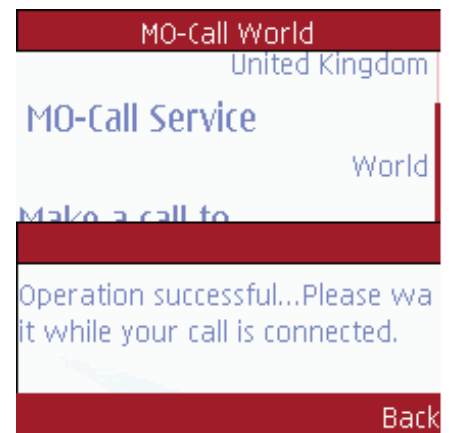
## 3. Highlight the “Call me at” field

Select “Edit” and type the number you want to receive your call back on, or find a contact from your phone book then select “OK”.



## 4. Select “Make a Call”

MO-Call will send an SMS to set up the call, and then call you back on the number you entered in “Call me at”. When you answer the callback, MO-Call will connect you to your destination.



If you leave the “Call me at” field blank, MO-Call will automatically direct your call back to your mobile number. Remember: you can direct a callback to any phone you have available nearby – even a fixed line phone. If you use a landline to receive the callback on, the MO-Call callback rate will often be much cheaper.

## **Making a Roaming Call with MO-Call World**

To avoid any kind of roaming charge, you MUST always direct your call back to a LOCAL landline or LOCAL mobile phone when roaming away from your SIM’s Home country. If you direct the call back to your roaming mobile, you will probably still incur an incoming Roaming Fee by your Mobile Network.

For example, if you're roaming in the USA with a UK SIM, always enter a local USA number in the "Call me at" field. It can be a local fixed number or local mobile number. If you leave the number blank, you'll receive the callback on your roaming UK mobile and most likely still get charged a Roaming Fee by your Mobile Network.

## ***Do you have local SIM cards for countries you visit regularly?***

If you visit a country regularly, why not consider obtaining a local SIM? All you need to do is register the local number at [www.mo-call.com](http://www.mo-call.com). If the country is a MO-Call Home country, we'll give you some free calling credit and you'll be able to make really cheap MO-Call Home calls. Even if the country isn't a MO-Call Home country, you can use MO-Call World with the local SIM. If your mobile is using a local number, callbacks to that local number will never incur a Roaming charge.
